

EDUCATION:

This past month, Kibuye offered clinical training to 43 medical students (as well as nursing, ophthalmology and anesthesia students). The Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation course was completed. 2 post-graduate physician interns graduated, and 4 more began to make a current total of 12. 14 post-graduate nursing, anesthesia, and lab interns are being trained.
